

Access and Amenity Fund – 2013-14 Projects

4 projects were awarded funding to the value of **£26,283**

In total 10 projects were considered by the panel

1. Suffolk Wildlife Trust – Heathland Restoration **£9,226**

Restoration of a 10.3ha BAP (Biodiversity Action Plan) heathland within Rendlesham Forest to create a richer landscape for people and wildlife

2. Eastfeast – ‘Birdswing’ **£4,500**

‘A feast for birds to raise the roof with ‘Birdswing’: bringing alive the birds and their birdsong. Children using technology, art and horticulture to reproduce birdsong in their classroom and share via the web. Targets 60+ children and parents

3. Pebble Media – Heritage Coast Radio **£8,528**

Heritage Coast Radio: Provide intellectual access to the area through the production (by young people and older experienced volunteers) of ten short community based radio ‘programmes’ for use by local radio providers

4. Quiet Lanes Suffolk – Pilot Project **£4,029**

Establish a 2013 pilot scheme of 6-10 quiet lanes in the AONB with accompanying campaign for their considerate use by all. If successful in that first phase, Quiet Lanes will then be extended in Phase 2 in 2014 elsewhere in the AONB.
