



Beachwatch equipment available to borrow

Thank you for your interest in Beachwatch.

For groups participating in Beachwatch and completing a survey for the Marine Conservation Society, we can loan the following items:

- Litter sticks (adult and child sizes)
- Bag hoops (adult and child sizes)
- Bin bags
- Scales
- Sharps boxes (only for needles)
- Pencils
- Litter ID cards
- Clipboards*

*We do have limited supplies of clipboards so if you are able to supply your own, we would be grateful.

How much equipment do you need?

We advise people to work in pairs when carrying out a Beachwatch survey, so 1 litter stick, bag hoop, clipboard and pencil between 2 people would be sufficient.

Survey sheets?

Once you have registered your Beachwatch event with MCS, you will gain access to all the online resources, including the Beach Clean Volunteer Survey Sheet which **you will need to print for your event.**
