



## Amenity and Accessibility Fund 2022-23

A total of £15,251.15 was awarded to ten projects.

### 1 Gillian Moon

£500

**Planet Suffolk - Love letters from a changing world:** A project that uses photography and storytelling to explore the global environmental crisis from a Suffolk viewpoint. Delivered through a series of visual storytelling workshops, a book and website the project aims to promote a deeper connection with and greater care for the landscapes of Suffolk and the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

### 2 Butley Ferry

£2,863.17

**Butley Ferry Boat Refurbishment:** To renovate the 50+ year old ferry to increase its service life, improve buoyancy and improve its general appearance

### 3 Suffolk Punch Trust

£1,000

**Pond dipping platform, interpretive rail, pond dipping equipment - with safety equipment:** As part of a multi-phase, multi-year programme of improvements to environmental and educational experience at The Suffolk Punch Trust - the project is to provide an easily accessible, safe platform which is inclusive and can be used for individuals, families, schools and community groups to use under the guidance of volunteers. The platform will have an interpretative safety rail with pictures of the pond's freshwater organisms [fauna]. Nets, trays and magnifying glasses will be used to study the freshwater organisms.

### 4 Waveney Bird Club

£2,500

**Swift Tower (Phase 1 – feasibility, design and build):** To design and build a Swift Tower to be erected on land owned by Walberswick Land Trust Charity. Structure to be designed by renowned local sculptor. Planning permission costs to be included as part of project.

### 5 Woodbridge Tidemill Charitable Trust

£1,995

**See the Light:** To provide a micro-generator inside the Mill. Demonstrating electricity generation from hydropower. To provide education interpretation and activities around STEM themes for KS1, and KS2-3 students.

### 6 Autism and Nature

£1,000

**Accessible activities to engage children with SEND with Suffolk's heath and coastal landscapes:** To provide resources to help parents, carers and teachers to engage in activities with children with SEND that help them to better understand and engage with some of the important natural landscapes in the Suffolk Coast & Heaths AONB.

### 7 RSPB Hollesley Marshes

£2,500

**Hollesley Marshes Nature Reserve accessibility for all project:** To replace the steps leading up the existing viewing platform at RSPB Hollesley Marshes with a ramp made from recycled plastic to make the wildlife viewing experience accessible to all visitors.

### 8 Friends of Hollesley School

£1,800

**Hollesley School Wildlife Area:** To create a forest school area within the grounds at Hollesley School. To develop the existing wildlife area.

### 9 Art Safari

£300

**Suffolk SketchFest:** To support the Bursary places for Suffolk SketchFest 2022, a 3-day celebration of sketching the maritime heritage & wildlife of the River Deben AONB at Woodbridge with artist-led walks, demonstrations and workshops. A worldwide audience can also tune in via Zoom and Facebook Live for specific events during the festival on the same themes.

**The John Gibbins Gallery Improvements Plan - Stage 2 improvements to lighting:** Improving lighting in the Gallery for a range of community events.
